Per Federal Law (NCLB), a student is legally homeless if he/she or his/her family is living in any of the following situations:
1) In a shelter, motel, vehicle or campground; 2) On the street; 3) In an abandoned building, trailer or other inadequate accommodation;
4) "doubled up," i.e. family moved in with another family because they lost permanent housing. Students permanently living with relatives (Kin Care) do not automatically qualify as homeless. Homeless students must be enrolled *immediately* with or without documentation, i.e. birth certificates, transcripts, or proof of residency. Homeless students must have access to *all* programs offered at school.
